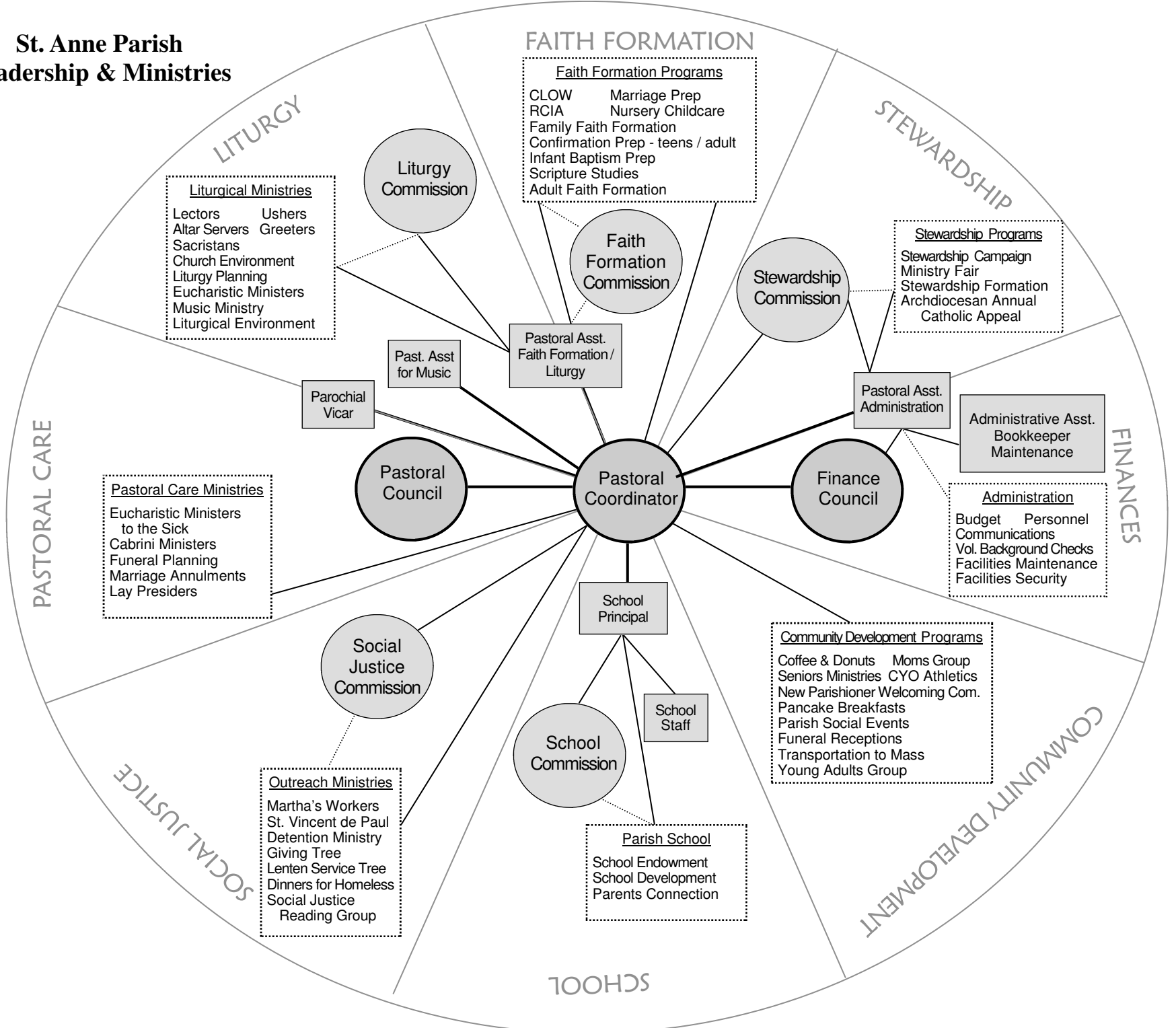


# St. Anne Parish Leadership & Ministries



## **Parish Leadership**

The councils and commissions provide leadership for the parish community by serving as consultative bodies to the Pastoral Coordinator. The councils (Pastoral and Finance) collaborate with the Pastoral Coordinator to address the challenges and opportunities of the overall parish. Commissions provide leadership in one particular area of parish life (e.g., school, liturgy, social justice). Both councils and commissions serve primarily through recommending priorities, strategic planning, and communication. New members are discerned through the Parish Discernment Process.
